Councilman Lahullier asked Rick Arango of Remington, Vernick & Arango for this monthly report. Mr. Arango reported on the following:

1. The Carlton Avenue Firehouse generator was set yesterday. The contractor is requesting an extension on the project until December 1st. Councilman Ravettine asked if there was a good reason for the extension. Mr. Arango stated that they have been working quickly but it's just a level of comfort for them because the generator was just set yesterday. Councilman Lahullier asked if he has been happy with their performance so far and Mr. Arango said yes. Councilman Lahullier made a motion to grant the extension until December 1, 2015 and to also approve a change order for a PSE&G upgrade that was needed for the project in the amount of \$986.00:

FIRE DEPT/EMERGENCY SQUAD – COUNCILMAN LAHULLIER

Councilman Lahullier stated that he is looking to an outstanding voucher that was sent to Carlstadt for their portion of the batting cages.

Councilman Lahullier questioned whether or not Steve Nagin should be cleaning the VFW room at borough hall. It was decided that he will do light cleaning such as the garbage, vacuuming and cleaning of the bathroom. He also stated that there is an

addition to the borough's Comcast bill due to the installation of cable in the room. It was decided that if they have a basic cable package then the borough will cover the full cost however if they have any type of premium package that the difference between the basic package and the premium package will be deducted from their snow removal check. Councilman Lahullier made a motion on both of these items:

Mayor Cassella stated that a proposal was received from Davis Carburetor to replace the existing generator at 312 Grove Street. The generator (Cummins/Onan) is used however it is in perfect condition and has less than 300 hours on it. The generator is a 6.8 litre V10 as opposed to the old 4.9 litre. For a cost of \$10,000 they will remove the old generator, redo the concrete, set the generator and rewire it to the existing transfer switch. Councilman Ravettine feels that a new generator should be purchase since it is our communication hub and also that we should not just give away the old generator because it could be sold at auction. Mayor Cassella asked for a motion on the proposal from Davis Carburetor in the amount of \$10,000:

Mayor Cassella submitted a proposal in the amount of \$21,000 from Montana Construction for the milling and paving of Chadwick Street. Engineer Beckmeyer explained that he met with them regarding the drainage and they gave him three options to try. He recommends option #1 in the amount of \$21,000 because there is no guarantee that any of the options will actually help with the drainage:
