RESOLUTION #116 – 2020

- WHEREAS, the Borough of East Rutherford, New Jersey, has experienced natural hazards that result in public safety hazards and damage to private and public property;
- WHEREAS, the hazard mitigation planning process set forth by the State of New Jersey and the Federal Emergency Management Agency offers the opportunity to consider natural hazards and risks, and to identify mitigation actions to reduce future risk through the adoption of a Bergen County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan ("Hazard Mitigation Plan"); and
- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management is providing federal mitigation funds to support development of the Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
- WHEREAS, a draft Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Mitigation Planning Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the draft Hazard Mitigation Plan includes a prioritized list of mitigation actions including activities that, over time, will help minimize and reduce safety threats and damage to private and public property; and
- WHEREAS, the draft Hazard Mitigation Plan was provided to each participating jurisdiction and was posted on the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management's website so as to introduce the planning concept and to solicit questions and comments; and to present the Hazard Mitigation Plan and request comments, as required by law; and
- WHEREAS, the draft Hazard Mitigation Plan was submitted by the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency on August 7, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency have approved the draft Hazard Mitigation Plan as submitted; and
- WHEREAS, formal adoption and maintenance of the Hazard Mitigation Plan by the governing body is a condition of receipt of federal disaster aid; and
- WHEREAS, the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management has recommended to the County Executive and Board of Chosen Freeholders that the Hazard Mitigation Plan, as submitted to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency on August 7, 2020, be adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the County of Bergen.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of East Rutherford, Bergen County, New Jersey that:

- 1. The Bergen County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, as submitted to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency on August 7, 2020 by the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management is hereby adopted as an official plan of the County of Bergen; minor revisions recommended by the Federal Emergency Management Agency and/or the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management may be incorporated without further action.
- 2. A hard copy of the Hazard Mitigation Plan shall be kept on file at the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management, and a digital copy shall be posted on the web site of the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management.
- 3. Any action proposed by the Hazard Mitigation Plan shall be subject to and contingent upon budget approval, if required, which shall be at the discretion of the Borough of East Rutherford, and this resolution shall not be interpreted so as to mandate any such appropriations.
- 4. The Borough of East Rutherford's Emergency Management Coordinator shall coordinate with their local offices and officials; and periodically report on the activities, accomplishments, and progress, and shall prepare an annual progress report to be submitted to the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management. The Bergen County Office of Emergency Management shall prepare an annual progress report on the goals and mitigation actions set forth in the Hazard Mitigation Plan. Copies of those reports will be kept on file at the office of the Board of Chosen Freeholders and the Bergen County Office of Emergency Management. Municipal status reports may be submitted at any time to the County Coordinator to amend mitigation actions identified in the Hazard Mitigation Plan. At a minimum, municipal status reports shall be submitted to the County Coordinator on an annual basis. The County Coordinator will identify one meeting per year that will address hazard mitigation updates, as required by the State of New Jersey's Hazard Mitigation Plan and its Standard Operating Procedure.

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE RENEWAL OF ENVIRONMENTAL LIABILITY COVERAGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CARRIER.

WHEREAS, the Borough entered into negotiations to secure property on Route 17 within the Borough for the purposes of a new Police and Court Complex in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the property has known contamination being remediated in accordance with NJDEP requirements by the former owner; and

WHEREAS, in coordination with the Borough Attorney and Engineer, the Borough's Risk Management Consultant secured a Pollution and Remediation Legal Liability policy in 2010 as an additional protection to the Borough for a 10-year period that expired November 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Risk Management Consultant has secured a 10-year renewal Pollution and Remediation Legal Liability policy proposal from AXA XL Insurance, an A.M. Best, "A" rated surplus lines carrier as an additional protection to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, after analysis, it was deemed most prudent and cost-effective for the Borough to secure coverage (without the Terrorism Coverage Option) with a \$5,000,000 Limit of Liability, with a \$50,000 Self-Insured Retention for a ten (10) year policy period, for a one-time premium, not to exceed \$108,500. including applicable fees and taxes, as required by State law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of East Rutherford, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that the Risk Management Consultant (RMC) is hereby directed to effectuate the coverage noted above in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the proposal presented by AXA XL Insurance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the documents necessary to effectuate the coverage set forth herein, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth (absent the Terrorism Coverage Option); and

RESOLUTION #128 - 2020

A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT THE STANDARD INSURANCE COMPANY TO PROVIDE A FULLY-INSURED SHORT-TERM DISABILITY PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD 01.01.21 THROUGH 12.31.23

WHEREAS, the Borough of East Rutherford (hereinafter, the Borough) provides a Short-Term Disability (STD) benefit through a self-funded program for all full-time eligible employees in accordance with longstanding past practice; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Health Benefits Consultant (HBC) was requested to review the Program, based upon the following:

- The Borough has maintained a Short-Term Disability (STD) Program for all municipal employees (excluding Police) for over 20 years on a self-funded basis; meaning the Borough both administered/adjudicated and also self-funded the cost of all STD claims.
- Over the timeframe the Borough has self-funded this coverage, the amount of personal time (sick, vacation, etc.) accumulated by municipal employees, on average, has decreased significantly, for a number of reasons.
- Consequently, the Borough has had to process these types of claims with increasing frequency and apply coverage determinations in adjudicating claims filed by covered employees; and

WHEREAS, given the change in dynamics, it was decided to explore the market for an insurance solution that provides professional, consistent adjudication at a competitive cost; and

WHEREAS, it is also advantageous for one carrier to administer both the STD and Long-Term Disability (LTD) programs, to ensure consistency and application during adjudication as well as a seamless transition, in the event an STD claim develops into an LTD claim; and

WHEREAS, consequently, the Standard Insurance Company has been a proven carrier for the Borough's LTD Program and consequently, the HBC solicited Proposals from them for consideration; and

WHEREAS, after negotiation, the HBC was able to secure a STD Program, underwritten by Standard Insurance Company (an "A" rated carrier specializing in disability programs that currently administers the Borough's LTD Program on a fully-insured basis) that accomplishes the following:

- Offers a Plan of Benefit that effectively matches the existing level of benefit.
- Provides seamless administration of the STD and LTD Programs
- Provides consistency in claims administration and adjudication utilizing recognized and established insurance protocols.
- Offers a potential Cost Savings to the Borough over the last two (2) years of claims activity.
- o Provides budget stability with Standard offering a three (3) year rate guarantee

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Rutherford, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, the Standard STD Proposal offering an equal to or better benefit for all eligible Borough employees and identified as Option 4 on the attached spreadsheet analysis prepared and presented by the Borough's Health Benefits Consultant (HBC) is hereby accepted and directed to the Mayor and Borough Administration for implementation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Mayor, Borough Clerk and Borough Benefits Consultant are hereby authorized to take the appropriate steps necessary to effectuate the coverage for a January 1, 2021 effective date, or as soon thereafter as administratively practical and without interruption to those eligible employees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the contract award for these services is directly to a duly licensed and admitted Insurance Company within the State of NJ and therefore, such award is exempt from the requirements set forth by P.L. 2004, Chapter 19 (as amended by P.L. 2005, c.51) N.J.S.A.19:44A-20.5 et seq.
