**RESOLUTION #25 - 2020**

**WHEREAS**, there exists in the Borough of East Rutherford a need for the services of an elevator inspection company to perform inspection and other elevator sub-code related services for the Borough's Building Department; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough of East Rutherford that said position should be appointed under a fair and open process, pursuant to the New Jersey Local Unit Pay to Play law, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1, et. seq. ("Pay to Play Law"); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Rutherford, New Jersey, as follows:

1. For the reasons above stated, the Borough Clerk is authorized to issue Requests for Proposal ("RFP") for Elevator Inspection Services for the Borough of East Rutherford, notice of which shall be publicly advertised, on or before January 28, 2020;

2. Responses to such RFP must be submitted no later than 10:00 a.m. on , Friday, February 14, 2020, at the Borough Clerk's Office at the Municipal Building, One Everett Place, East Rutherford, New Jersey.

3. The Mayor shall be authorized to appoint a committee not to exceed three (3) persons, who shall review the responses submitted to the RFPs with respect to the appointments, and make a determination whether there has been compliance with all specifications and requirements thereof, and make a recommendation to the governing body for the award of the contract. All submissions in response shall be evaluated on the basis of the most advantageous submission, all factors considered, including, but not limited to:

- a. Price to be charged to the Borough.
- b. Experience and reputation in the field.
- c. Knowledge of the Borough of East Rutherford and the subject matter to be addressed under the contract.
- d. Availability to accommodate any required meetings of the Council and its related sub-entities, as necessary
- e. Availability to accommodate any required court appearances or other necessary meetings on behalf of the Borough.
- f. Any other factors determined to be in the best interest of the Borough.

4. Such appointment shall be subject to the preparation and execution of an agreement, or memoranda of understanding.

5. The Mayor and Council have determined that the terms of this Resolution constitute a fair and open process as to all positions included herein.

6. A copy of this Resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Borough of East Rutherford, within ten (10) days, according to law.

## **RESOLUTION #26 - 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c. 102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgated recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2019 Recycling Tonnage Grant will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Borough of East Rutherford to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of East Rutherford that the Borough of East Rutherford hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates a certified employee of the Bergen County Utilities Authority, pursuant to shared services contract, to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the monies from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

**RESOLUTION #27 – 2020**  
**Mutual Aid Plan & Rapid Deployment Force**  
**Interlocal Service Agreement**

WHEREAS, the Police Departments in Bergen County have a day-to-day responsibility to provide for the security of lives and property, for the maintenance and preservation of the public peace and order; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officials also have a responsibility to provide for the preparedness against natural emergencies, such as floods, hurricanes, earthquakes, major storms, etc., manmade causes, civic unrest, and civil disobedience such as riots, strikes, jail or prison riots, train wrecks, aircraft crashes, major fires, ethnic disorder riots, terrorist incidents and bombings, State and National Emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Police Chief's Association has proposed a Mutual Aid Plan and Rapid Deployment Force to deal with these emergencies which is adopted in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-156, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-156.1, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-156.4, and N.J.S.A. App. A:9-40.6; and

WHEREAS, this Plan will provide a uniform procedure for the coordination of the requesting, dispatching and utilization of law enforcement personnel and equipment whenever a local law enforcement agency requires mutual aid assistance from any other jurisdiction, both contiguous and non-contiguous, in the event of an emergency, riot or disorder in order to protect life and property; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Rutherford to participate in a Mutual Aid Plan and Rapid Deployment Force in accordance with the plan submitted by the Bergen County Police Chief's Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Rutherford that the East Rutherford Police Department, under the direction of the Chief of Police, cooperate with the Bergen County Police Chief's Association to create an Interlocal Services Agreement with all municipalities in the County of Bergen in order to put into place the Mutual Aid Plan and Rapid Deployment Force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the County Executive, the Board of Chosen Freeholders, the County Prosecutor and all Bergen County Municipalities;

## **RESOLUTION #28 - 2020**

Whereas, the Borough of East Rutherford strongly believes in and supports open transparent government and that its citizens and residents have the right to be informed about the workings of government in order to best participate in a democracy; and

Whereas, on January 8, 2002 then Acting Governor DiFrancesco signed into law the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) which mandates that government records shall be available, with limited exceptions, for public access and simplifying the procedures for requesting such specific records; and

Whereas, the intent of the law was to provide the public with easy access to government records with an uncomplicated process for obtaining the records and eliminating bureaucratic red tape; and

Whereas, over the course of 18 years, OPRA has been a positive light, but it has also been fraught with abuse and misuse and has become an unanticipated financial cost to the taxpayers of New Jersey; and

Whereas, the Borough of East Rutherford has labored under a well-intended law that has spiraled out of control, due to the volume and nature of requests, the cost to taxpayers in responding to requests, and the potential liability in having to pay disproportionate prevailing party attorney's fees should the request turn into litigated matters, as well as the liability in determining which documents shall be released, with or without redaction, while attempting to maintain the individual privacy; and

Whereas, it is not only the volume of OPRA requests that challenge our resources, but its also the cost associated with reviewing, retrieving and processing the OPRA request(s) by public entity personnel and counsel and possibly defending our action(s) before the Government Records Council or in Superior Court; and

Whereas, the Borough of East Rutherford received and responded to 282 OPRA requests in 2019, a number that is increasing each year.

Whereas, the Borough of East Rutherford municipal staff has spent a multitude of hours responding to OPRA requests received over the years; and

Whereas, due to the often-conflicting case law and Government Record Council decisions, as well as the unique characteristics of OPRA request, the Borough of East Rutherford must often rely on the municipal attorney to review certain OPRA request, resulting in additional fees in response to OPRA requests; and

Whereas, with limited exceptions OPRA has not been amended to address the clear and apparent advancement in technology that has changed the way government records are created, stored, and/or transmitted; the various interpretive decision; privacy concerns; abuse for commercial gain; and/or the ever increasing cost to taxpayers; and

Whereas, as the current law approaches its twentieth (20<sup>th</sup>) anniversary it has outgrown its original intended use and has become ripe for comprehensive review and reform;

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Governing Body of the Borough of East Rutherford appeals to the legislature to form a Commission comprised of Mayors, Municipal Clerks, Municipal Managers, Attorneys, Police Chiefs, open government advocates, privacy experts, members of the media, citizens and other appropriate stakeholders, to review and examine the effects of OPRA on local government and the

needs to be fulfilled by the law, and use the Commission's findings to perform a comprehensive reform of OPRA;

Be It Further Resolved, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to Senator Paul Sarlo, Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin, Senate President Stephen Sweeney, Senator Loretta Weinberg, Executive Director of the Government Records Council, the Governor of the State of New Jersey, the Municipal Clerks Association of New Jersey and the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.

**RESOLUTION #30 – 2020**

**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER (P.A.C.O.)**

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2 et. seq. each public agency shall annually designate an officer or employee to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer (P.A.C.O.); and

WHEREAS, the individual designated as the Public Agency Compliance Officer will be the point of contact for all matters concerning implementation and administration of the legal requirements of the Equal Employment Opportunity Monitoring Program; and

WHEREAS, the Public Agency Compliance Officer is also responsible for administering contracting procedures pertaining to equal employment regarding both the public agency and its service providers; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.3, each public agency shall notify the State of New Jersey, Department of the Treasury, Division of Purchase & Property, Contract Compliance Audit Unit, EEO Monitoring Program of its designation by January 10<sup>th</sup> of each year; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to designate Danielle Lorenc, Municipal Clerk, to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2020; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of East Rutherford that Danielle Lorenc is hereby designated to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2020.

## RESOLUTION #31 - 2020

**WHEREAS**, as of January 1, 2006, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq., commonly known as the “State Pay to Play” law enacted by the New Jersey State Legislature became effective; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq., a municipality may not award contracts with a value in excess of \$17,500.00 to a business entity which has made reportable contributions in excess of \$300.00, in the aggregate, to the said municipality’s political parties or to any candidate’s committee of any person serving in an elective public office of the said municipality when such contract was awarded, unless said business entity is awarded a contract under a “fair and open process” pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, a “fair and open process” constitutes the following: (1) public advertisement of a Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) with at least ten calendar days notice before the receipt of responses to the RFQ; (2) award of contract under a process that provides for public solicitation of qualifications; (3) award of contract under publicly-disclosed criteria established, in writing, by the municipality before the solicitation of qualifications; and (4) the municipality shall publicly open and announce the qualifications when awarded; and

**WHEREAS**, there exists in the Borough of East Rutherford a need for the services of a Special Counsel for conflict tax appeals and building code enforcement for the year 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough of East Rutherford that said positions should be appointed under a fair and open process, pursuant to the New Jersey Local Unit Pay to Play law, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1, et. seq. (“Pay to Play Law”); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Rutherford, New Jersey, as follows:

1. For the reasons above stated, the Borough Clerk is authorized to issue Requests for Qualifications (“RFQs”) for a Special Counsel for conflict tax appeals and building code enforcement for the Borough of East Rutherford, notice of which shall be publicly advertised and posted on the Borough’s website, as required in the Pay to Play Law, on or before January 28, 2020;

2. Responses to such RFQ’s must be submitted no later than 10:00 a.m. on Friday, February 14, 2020, at the Borough Clerk’s Office at the Municipal Building, One Everett Place, East Rutherford, New Jersey.

3. The Mayor shall be authorized to appoint a committee not to exceed three (3) persons, which committee shall consist of the Mayor and/or Governing Body officials, who shall review the responses submitted to the RFQs with respect to the appointments, and make a determination whether there has been compliance with all specifications and requirements thereof, and make a recommendation for the appointment to the governing body. All submissions in response shall be evaluated on the basis of the most advantageous submission, all factors considered, including, but not limited to:

a. Experience and reputation in the field;

b. Knowledge of the Borough of East Rutherford and the subject matter to be addressed under the contract;

c. Availability to accommodate any required meetings of the Council and its related sub-entities, as necessary;

d. Availability to accommodate any required court appearances or other necessary meetings on behalf of the Borough;

e. Any other factors determined to be in the best interest of the Borough.

4. Such appointment shall be subject to the preparation and execution of an agreement, or memoranda of understanding.

5. The Mayor and Council have determined that the terms of this Resolution constitute a fair and open process as to all positions included herein.
