RESOLUTION #131 – 2021 GOVERNING BODY CERTIFICATION OF THE ANNUAL AUDIT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year 2020 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall, by resolution, certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed, as a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations, as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of <u>R.S.</u> 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Rutherford, hereby states that it has complied with N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5 and does hereby submit a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.

Resolution #132 - 2021

WHEREAS, Local Finance Notice 92-15 issued by the Division of Local Government Services requires all municipalities to prepare a Corrective Action Plan as part of its annual audit process; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has prepared the attached Corrective Action Plan in conjunction with the appropriate department heads;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the attached Corrective Action Plan is approved by the Mayor & Council of the Borough of East Rutherford as required by Local Finance Notice 92-15.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

Corrective Action Plan Borough of East Rutherford, Bergen County, NJ 2020 Audit Report

Finding Number 1

Description: The Current Account and Construction Code did not comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15 which states all collected monies be deposited within 48 hours of receipt.

Analysis: All monies collected must be deposited in the bank with 48 hours.

Corrective Action: All Borough Personnel have been notified to make deposits within 48 hours of receipt.

Implementation Date: Effective immediately.

• Finding Number 2

Description: Purchases from four vendors for preventative building & grounds maintenance, roof repairs, building upgrades and emergency generators exceeded the bidding law threshold in aggregate and were not advertised for bids in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law.

Analysis: That expenditures be monitored for compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law.

Corrective Action: The Borough CFO, Purchasing Agent and Department Heads will review and ensure that all purchases are made in compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law.

Implementation Date: Effective immediately.

Finding Number 3

Description: The tax department posting errors included an error that was incorrectly posted to another account and tax credits were refunded but not posted to tax accounts, and the overpayment created was not detected and corrected until 2021.

Analysis: That tax payments be posted more carefully, and tax reports be reviewed from time to time by the tax collector.

Corrective Action: The tax collector responsible for these errors left the Borough in January 2021. The newly hired collector was made aware of these errors and have since been corrected.

Implementation Date: Effective immediately.

Finding Number 4

Description: Although the DCA fees were charged correctly in the permit software, it was noted that the fee ordinance as well as the eCode on the Borough's website maintained the outdated DCA fee amounts to be charged by permit. Not all fees charged in the permit software are listed in the fee ordinance.

Analysis: That the Borough reviews and updates the construction code fee ordinance and be consistent with the eCode on the website.

Corrective Action: That the Borough's Building Department give the Borough Clerk update's for the fee ordinance and the Borough Council adopt the new fee ordinance.

Implementation Date: To be completed by year end.

Finding Number 5

Description: During the examination of employee files, it was noted that numerous employee files did not include required IRS Forms I-9 and/or W-4.

Analysis: That controls be implemented and monitored to ensure that all required forms are included in employee files.

Corrective Action: The appropriate Borough personnel will update the files for the missing I-9's and all employees will be given W-4's to complete and placed in their files.

Implementation Date: To be completed by year end.

Finding Number 6

Description: An incorrect premium plan was used to calculate employee health benefit contributions in some instances.

Analysis: That controls be implemented and monitored to ensure that employee health benefits contributions are accurate.

Corrective Action: The Borough's payroll administrator was made aware of these errors and has since corrected them.

Implementation Date: Effective immediately.

Finding Number 7

Description: Form 941 (Employers Quarterly Federal Tax Return) social security wages reported did not agree with Form W3 (Annual Transmission of Wages & Tax Statements) wages reported.

Analysis: That controls be implemented and monitored to reconcile the Borough's Form 941 to its Form W3.

Corrective Action: The appropriate Borough personnel will review these forms for any errors. The payroll service did not file these changes in 2020, consequently creating the error. The payroll service was contacted in July and is filing an amended 2020 941's.

Implementation Date: Effectively immediately.

Finding Number 8

Description: Bail and general account receipts were not always deposited in the bank within 48 hours.

Analysis: All monies collected must be deposited in the bank with 48 hours.

Corrective Action: The Court Administrator has been notified to make deposits within 48 hours of receipt.

Implementation Date: Effective immediately.
